

CITY OF PITT MEADOWS
2025 GOOD GOVERNANCE REPEAL BYLAW
No. 3015, 2025

A bylaw to repeal expired or otherwise obsolete bylaws identified through
the 2025 bylaw review process.

WHEREAS the *Community Charter* requires that a bylaw must be repealed through the enactment of another bylaw;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient to repeal bylaws that are expired or otherwise obsolete;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Pitt Meadows enacts as follows:

Citation/Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "2025 Good Governance Repeal Bylaw No. 3015, 2025".

Definitions

2. In this bylaw:

Obsolete means expired, no longer in force, superseded by more current legislation, or no longer serves a practical purpose in City operations.

Repeal
