CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF PITT MEADOWS

BY-LAW No. 357

A BY-LAW providing for the borrowing of such sums of money as may be requisite to meet the current lawful expenditure of the Municipality.

WHEREAS by Section 262 of the Municipal Act of the Province of British Columbia, being chapter 42 of the Statutes of 1957 as amended by chapter 32 of the Statutes of 1958, a Municipal Council is empowered without the assent of the electors or the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities by by-law to provide for the borrowing of such sums of money as may be requisite to meet the current lawful expenditures of the Municipality, such borrowings not to exceed in the aggregate:

(i) The sum of:

the whole unencumbered amount of taxes due the Municipality in respect of the immediately preceding year plus

the whole amount of unpaid taxes for all purposes levied or to be levied during the current year, less the total liability previously incurred under the said Section:

or:

(ii) Seventy-five per centum of the whole levy made in the immediately preceding year.

AND WHEREAS the aggregate that the Council may presently borrow, calculated in accordance with (i) or (ii) above, is \$ Seventy Five Thousand Three Hundred and Ninety Dollars
AND WHEREAS to meet the current lawful expenditures of the Municipality, it is requisite that the Council borrow \$ Sixty Thousand Dollars

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Pitt Meadows hereby enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the said Municipal Council to borrow upon the credit of the Corporation from the Bank of Montreal the sum of Sixty Thousand----- dollars (\$ 60,000), in such amounts and at such times as the same may be required, and to pay interest thereon at a rate not exceeding $5\frac{3}{4}\%$ per annum.
2. All the moneys so borrowed and interest payable thereon shall be payable on or before the 31st. day of December, 19 60.

4. There is hereby set aside as security for the liability hereby authorized to be incurred:

(a) \$ _____, being the whole unencumbered amount of unpaid taxes due to the municipality at the end of the immediately preceding year, and

(b) \$ _____, being the whole of the taxes for the current year,

or

\$ 60,000-----, being that part of the taxes for the current year deemed by the Municipal Council expedient to be so set aside.

5. This by-law may be cited as TEMPORARY LOAN BY-LAW No. 357 of 19 60 .

BY-LAW NO. 360

A By-law to fix the rates and provide for the collection of taxes on assessable land and improvements in the Corporation of the District of Pitt Meadows for the year 1960.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF PITT MEADOWS in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. There shall be imposed, levied and collected for the year 1960 upon the assessed value of all rateable land in the Corporation of the District of Pitt Meadows as shown by the last revised assessment roll thereof and upon seventy-five per centum of the assessed value of the rateable improvements thereon, rates as follows:

- (a) To provide for the amounts required for the year 1960 under by-laws of the Municipality to meet payments of interest and principal of debts incurred by the Municipality for which other provision has not been made, a rate of 3 mills on the dollar.
 - (b) To provide for moneys required for the ordinary expenditures of the School Board, including the share of the municipality for debts incurred for school purposes, according to the requisition submitted to the Council by the School Board, a rate of 21.3 mills on the dollar.
 - (c) To provide for moneys required for all lawful general purposes of the municipality, including due provisions for uncollectable taxes and for taxes that it is estimated will not be collected during the year, but not including the moneys required under by-laws of the municipality to meet payments of interest and principal of debts incurred by the municipality, or required for the share of the municipality of the expenses of the School Board, or required for charges for the payment of which specific provision is otherwise made in the Municipal Act, a rate of 10 mills on the dollar.
2. The sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) shall be the minimum amount of taxation in any year on any parcel of taxable land upon the assessment roll.
3. The said rates shall be payable to the Collector of the


Corporation of the District of Pitt Meadows at his office in the Municipality of Pitt Meadows on the second day of July A.D 1960.

4. Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 382 of the "Municipal Act", and no tax notices have been transmitted during the year 1960 under Section 371 prior to the passage of this by-law, the Collector shall, upon the 18th day of October, 1960 add to the current year's taxes unpaid on each parcel of land or improvements upon his roll 5% of the amount thereof, and upon the 18th day of November, 1960 shall add an additional amount of 5% thereof, so that the total of 10% shall be added on taxes unpaid on the 31st day of December, in the year 1960, and the said unpaid taxes together with the amounts so added, shall be deemed to be the taxes of the current year due on such lands and on the improvements thereon, and the amount added hereunder shall, when collected, form part of the general revenue of the Municipality.
5. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as "Pitt MEADOWS REVENUE TAX BY-LAW 1960." No.360"

A BY-LAW providing for the borrowing of such sums of money as may be requisite to meet the current lawful expenditure of the Municipality.

WHEREAS by Section 262 of the Municipal Act of the Province of British Columbia, being chapter 42 of the Statutes of 1957 as amended by chapter 32 of the Statutes of 1958, a Municipal Council is empowered without the assent of the electors or the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities by by-law to provide for the borrowing of such sums of money as may be requisite to meet the current lawful expenditures of the Municipality, such borrowings not to exceed in the aggregate:

(i) The sum of:

the whole unencumbered amount of taxes due the Municipality in respect of the immediately preceding year plus

the whole amount of unpaid taxes for all purposes levied or to be levied during the current year, less the total liability previously incurred under the said Section:

or:

(ii) Seventy-five per centum of the whole levy made in the immediately preceding year.

AND WHEREAS the aggregate that the Council may presently borrow, calculated in accordance with ~~(i)~~ (ii) above, is \$ 74,632 .

AND WHEREAS to meet the current lawful expenditures of the Municipality, it is requisite that the Council borrow \$65,000 .

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Pitt Meadows hereby enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the said Municipal Council to borrow upon the credit of the Corporation from the Bank of Montreal the sum of sixty five thousand dollars (\$ 65,000), in such amounts and at such times as the same may be required, and to pay interest thereon at a rate not exceeding 5 ³/₄ % per annum.

2. All the moneys so borrowed and interest payable thereon shall be payable on or before the 31st day of December 19 61 .

4. There is hereby set aside as security for the liability hereby authorized to be incurred:

(a) \$ _____, being the whole unencumbered amount of unpaid taxes due to the municipality at the end of the immediately preceding year, and

(b) \$ _____, being the whole of the taxes for the current year,

or

\$ 65,000, being that part of the taxes for the current year deemed by the Municipal Council expedient to be so set aside.





THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF PITT MEADOWS in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. There shall be imposed, levied and collected for the year 1961 upon the assessed value of all rateable land in the Corporation of the District of Pitt Meadows as shown by the last revised assessment roll thereof and upon seventy-five per centum of the assessed value of the rateable improvements thereon, rates as follows:


- (a) To provide for the amounts required for the year 1961 under by-laws of the Municipality to meet payments of interest and principal of debts incurred by the Municipality for which other provision has not been made, a rate of $3\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the dollar.
 - (b) To provide for moneys required for the ordinary expenditures of the School Board, including the share of the municipality for debts incurred for school purposes, according to the requisition submitted to the Council by the School Board, a rate of $20\frac{7}{8}$ mills on the dollar.
 - (c) To provide for moneys required for all lawful general purposes of the municipality, including due provisions for uncollectable taxes and for taxes that it is estimated will not be collected during the year, but not including the moneys required under by-laws of the municipality to meet payments of interest and principal of debts incurred by the municipality, or required for the share of the municipality of the expenses of the School Board, or required for charges for the payment of which specific provision is otherwise made in the Municipal Act, a rate of $\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the dollar.
2. The sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) shall be the minimum amount of taxation in any year on any parcel of taxable land upon the assessment roll.

(3) The said rates shall be payable to the Corporation of the District of Pitt Meadows at his office in the Municipality of Pitt Meadows on the second day of July A.D. 1961.





BY-LAW No. 372

A BY-LAW providing for the borrowing of money for a purpose of a capital nature within the jurisdiction of the Municipal Council, and for levying rates for the payment of the debt thus created.

WHEREAS by Section 246 of the Municipal Act of the Province of British Columbia, being chapter 42 of the Statutes of 1907 as amended by chapter 32 of the Statutes of 1955, it is provided that where a Municipal Council deems it necessary or advisable to contract a debt for any purpose of a capital nature, such debt not to exceed at any time a total amount equal to five dollars multiplied by the population figure of the municipality, or one hundred thousand dollars, whichever is the lesser, the Council may by by-law, without the assent of the owner-electors, contract the debt by borrowing and make due provision for the repayment of the debt and any interest thereon.

AND WHEREAS the amount of existing obligations of the Municipality authorized under Section 246 at the date hereof is \$ Nil

AND WHEREAS the amount of the existing debenture debt of the Municipality at the date hereof is \$ 93,500

AND WHEREAS principal and interest payable on the said debenture debt (which) is not in arrears (of) is in arrears in the amount of \$ /

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it necessary or advisable to borrow the sum of \$8,257.00

for the following objects and purposes which are purposes of a capital nature, namely:

Installation of an 8-inch cast iron watermain along Bonson Road from Lougheed Highway to Hammond Road, and a 6-inch line along Hammond Road and Bonson Road south to the new Junior High School at 116B Avenue; Also installation of a 4-inch waterline along Ford Road a distance of 2,520 feet.

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities has been obtained.

AND WHEREAS the following further consents and approvals have been obtained as required by law, namely:

1. There shall be imposed, levied and collected for the year 1969 upon the assessed value of all rateable land in the Corporation of the District of Pitt Meadows as shown by the last revised assessment roll thereof and upon seventy-five per centus of the assessed value of the rateable improvements thereon, rates as follows:-

- (a) To provide for moneys required for all lawful general purposes of the municipality, including due provision for uncollectable taxes and for taxes that it is estimated will not be collected during the year, but not including the moneys required under by-laws of the municipality to meet payments of interest and principal of debts incurred by the municipality, or required for the share of the municipality of the expenses of the regional hospital district, or required for charges for the payment of which specific provision is otherwise made in the Municipal Act, a rate of 17 mills on the dollar.
- (b) To provide for the amounts required for the year 1969 under by-laws of the Municipality to meet payments of interest and principal of debts incurred by the Municipality for which other provision has not been made, a rate of 1.7 mills on the dollar.
- (c) To provide for the moneys which, when added to the amount remaining in the Hospital Rate Account from the previous year, are sufficient for the share of the Municipality for the expenses of the regional hospital district, and the share of the municipality for debts incurred for hospital purposes, according to the requisition submitted to the Council by the Regional Hospital Board, a rate of 2.24 mills on the dollar.

2. The sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) shall be the minimum amount of taxation in any year on any parcel of taxable real property upon the assessment roll.'

3. Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 384 of the "Municipal Act", and no tax notices have been transmitted during the year 1969 under Section 374 prior to the passage of this by-law, the Collector shall, upon the 17th day of October, 1969 add to the current year's taxes unpaid on each parcel of land or improvements upon his roll 5% of the amount thereof, and upon the 17th day of November, 1969 shall add an additional amount of 5% thereof, so that the total of 10% shall be added on taxes unpaid on the 31st day of December, in the year 1969, and the said unpaid taxes together with the amounts so added, shall be deemed to be the taxes of the current year due on such lands and on the improvements thereon, and the amount added hereunder shall, when collected, form part of the general revenue of the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the aggregate that the Council may presently borrow, calculated in accordance with ~~(i)~~ (ii) above is \$ 171,892.94

AND WHEREAS to meet the current lawful expenditures of the Municipality, it is requisite that the Council borrow \$ 171,800.00

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the DISTRICT of PITT MEADOWS hereby enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the said Municipal Council to borrow upon the credit of the Corporation from the Bank of Montreal the sum of One Hundred & Seventy One Thousand Eight Hundred ----- dollars (\$ 171,800), in such amounts and at such times as the same may be required, and to pay interest thereon at the rate not exceeding $8\frac{1}{2}$ % per annum.


