The City was awarded \$80,634 in federal grant funding from Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada to support the development of a community orchard and edible garden within Grabenhorst Garden. 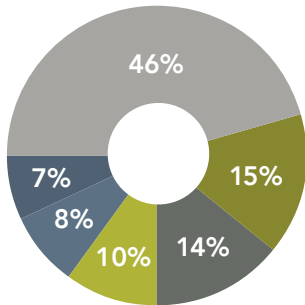

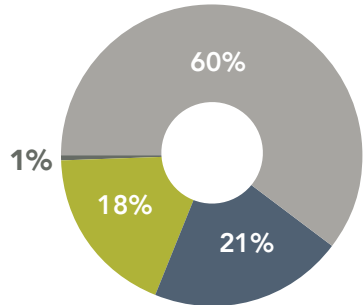
