Mayor & Council

Council endorsed the signing of the Project Partnering Agreement (PPA) to progress the design of the Harris Road Underpass with future consultation planned with the community. Autonomous RCMP Detachment Approved

Mayor and Council celebrated the Province's approval for the City to proceed with the creation of an autonomous RCMP detachment with a ribbon-cutting ceremony on the site of the future RCMP building. The 2022 budget focuses on the strategic priorities of public safety, maintaining service levels, and supporting community needs. The budget also provides for new initiatives to increase cultural understanding related to Truth and Reconciliation, anti-racism, and equity, diversity and inclusion. Parks, Recreation and Culture Master Plan

The City has adopted its first independent Parks, Recreation and Culture (PRC) Master Plan after hearing from thousands of residents and user groups over the last year. Amenity Lands Ribbon Cutting

Council celebrated the transfer of ownership of Onni's Amenity Land contribution to the City with an official ribbon cutting. The land includes 13 acres of parkland and an enhanced trail network, with an estimated value of \$22.5 million. Recommending the land use will be a priority of the new Parks, Recreation and Culture Advisory Committee the City is establishing in 2022.

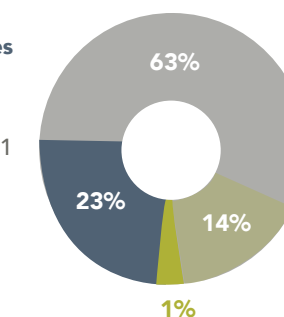
