#### DISCUSSION

#### Background:

Council Policy C090 Volunteer Program was identified for review as part of the overall city wide policy review process. This policy was established in November 2016 based on a similar policy within the Joint Leisure Services Agreement (JLSA) framework. The City has a strong track record of working with Volunteers within Special Events, Pitt Meadows Art Gallery and Emergency Social Services. This policy will support additional growth for the Volunteer Program.

### Analysis:

Policy C90 has been renamed to be C090 – Volunteer Program and is intended to:

- Continue to support a successful Volunteer Program for City events and services;
- Define different types of volunteers and requirements for the various age groups;
- Simplify the explanation of screening process; and
- Update the format to the new Council Policy template.
