

CLOSED ITEMS RELEASED TO THE PUBLIC

At the April 21, 2020 Special (Closed) meeting of Council, Pitt Meadows City Council resolved to release the following closed items to the public:

A. February 4, 2020 Closed Meeting of Council

TOPIC: Police Services Review

SUMMARY:

Council approved a community-wide mailout advertising the February 18 2020 Engagement & Priorities Committee meeting pertaining to the Police Services Review; AND

B. February 25, 2020 Closed Meeting of Council

TOPIC: Annual Renewal, Leases and Licences to Occupy Municipally Owned Property and Park Caretaker Agreements

SUMMARY:

Council approved the annual renewal of leases and licenses to occupy municipally owned property and park caretaker agreements; AND

TOPIC: Public Participation at Council Meetings

TOPIC: Fire Hall Mural

SUMMARY:

After careful consideration, Council endorsed Staff's recommendation to forego the preservation of the Fire Hall mural painted and generously donated to the City in 2013. Due to technical challenges, risk of damage, and high costs associated with this type of initiative, it was not considered feasible. Letters have been sent to the artist and community donors that contributed to this public art piece. A professional photo of the mural will be hung at the new Fire Hall.
