  - A.3 permits flexibility of operating hours during those additional special events, between 9am and 6pm, but not to exceed an eight (8) hour duration per special event; AND
- B. Direct staff to work with the Pitt Meadows Gun Club to develop a section 219 Covenant regarding environmental testing and monitoring; AND
- C. Adopt Discharge of Firearms Bylaw Amendment Bylaw No. 2802, 2018; AND
- D. Adopt Bylaw Notice Enforcement Amendment Bylaw No. 2804, 2018; AND
- E. Rescind direction to Staff to seek a 'Good Neighbour Agreement' related to the Pitt Meadows Gun Club; AND
- F. Direct Staff to advocate to the province on behalf of the City to implement impulsive sound guidelines for shooting ranges in the province of BC.
