1. <u>Bylaw Updates Pertaining to the Pitt Meadows Gun Club (File 09-3900-02/17)(Page 35)</u>

- A. Give first, second and third readings to Noise Control Bylaw Amendment Bylaw No. 2858, 2020 which:
 - A.1 confirms regular operating hours for outdoor shooting ranges to be limited to Wednesday evenings (6pm-9pm) and Sundays (10am-4pm);
 - A.2 permits outdoor shooting ranges to host up to eight (8) additional special events per year with no more than two (2) additional special events per month; AND
 - A.3 permits flexibility of operating hours during those additional special events, between 9am and 6pm, but

not to exceed an eight (8) hour duration per special event; AND

- B. Direct staff to work with the Pitt Meadows Gun Club to develop a section 219 Covenant regarding environmental testing and monitoring; AND
- C. Adopt Discharge of Firearms Bylaw Amendment Bylaw No. 2802, 2018; AND

- The Corporate Officer reserves the right to limit or defer questions and comments from the public due to time constraints or inappropriate content.
- Emails received prior to the meeting will be read out during the first Question & Comment period, in the order that they are received. Emails received during the Council meeting, pertaining to decisions made by Council that evening, will be prioritized and read during the second Question & Comment Period.
